In the USA, children younger than 5 go to a nursery school/ preschool.

When they are five or six years old, they start elementary school which lasts six years. The fist year at elementary school is called kindergarten. After elementary school, students attend middle school (also known as junior high school) for three years.

Then they continue at high school. They stay there until they are 16 or 18 years old.

## Subjects - Welche Fächer gibt es in Amerika???

At elementary school pupils primarily learn how to read, write and count. (lesen, schreiben, rechnen) There are about 20 to 30 pupils (Schülerinnen) in one class.

At junior and senior high school children take subjects like English, Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Physical education and History. Schools also offer extra courses. Students can choose Art, French or German, Chinese and computers. Physical education (Sports) is a very important subject in the United States - many students take part in sports programs.

## Grading - Wie benoten die eigentlich in Amerika???

In the USA (as in other English speaking countries) letter grades (Buchstabennoten) are used in reports.

& \text { A > } 90 \% \text { correct (excellent) } \\
& B>80 \% \text { (very good) } \\
& C>70 \% \text { (improvement needed) } \\
& \text { D }>60 \% \text { (close fail) } \\
& E>50 \% \text { (fail) } \\
& \text { F }<50 \% \text { (fail) }
\end{aligned}
$$

In general, only grades $A$ to $C$ are a 'pass' - a plus (+) or minus (-) might be added (e. g. A-, B+).
